During the conference, delegates are required to form up into teams of representatives for different countries and participate in an intensive 3-day discussion of many far reaching international issues.

APPLICATION REMINDERS FOR DELEGATES

- Hong Kong Model United Nations Conference 2020 accepts both individual and team application. Non-local delegates are not accepted due to recent COVID-19 measures. Local delegate includes local Hong Kong students and non-local students who are currently studying and residing in Hong Kong.
- For team application, each team should consist of 2 to 6 delegates; 2 delegates may be assigned to the same committee in each team. Please be reminded that delegates in the same team may NOT be representing the same country in different committees.
- WHO & DISEC are in single or mixed delegation, delegates in the same team might be assigned to double delegation when necessary; UNHRC is in double delegation, each 2 delegates in a team should choose the same preferred country and committee to be paired up. Should there be any dispute, HKMUNC reserves the right to the final decision of country allocation.
- Delegates must attend all the activities organised in the 3-day conference.

ADVISOR/OBSERVER ARRANGEMENT

- A maximum of 2 advisors or 2 observers per team will be accepted to the Conference.*
